

The GTC summer conference this July will be a blessing to many pastors in Colombia, as the new module, *What is a Healthy Church?*, is presented by an eager team of pastors and professors. The conference, from July 17th to the 30th include: GTC Board members, President Bryant Skinner, Dr. Don Galardi, Pastor Harry Stoliker, and Dr. Noé Acosta, Founder and Executive Director of GTC. Returning presenters are: Pastor Oscar Arocha and Pastor Juan Jose Perez, both from the Dominican Republic, and Pastor Keith Maddy.



We welcome, to the GTC missionary team, Dr. Chris Hatton, pastor of Grace Chapel of Sanford, Florida, and author of the book, *30 Days to a Biblical Worldview*. Pastor Hatton is Founder and Pastoral Chair of the Reformation Society of Florida and the Spurgeon Fellowship of Florida. Pastor Hatton will be one of the guest speakers at a retreat of Reformed Pastors, in Medellin, where he will be sharing the process that the Confessing Evangelicals are following in the USA in order to have confraternity, mutual cooperation and encouragement by pastors engaged in the process of reforming congregations.

This July indicates, also, an historic episode in the ministry of GTC. GTC Board Members will participate in a special transitional planning for the future of GTC. During the next five years, GTC will responsibly empower the Reformed pastors of Colombia to train more capable men to continue the reformation movement that GTC began in South America. GTC will remain at the service of these pastors and Reformed churches, helping with the finance of the modules, enabling pastors and churches, as the Lord permits, to carry the Gospel of Grace throughout Colombia and, Lord willing, around the world!

GTC is grateful to the participating pastors and to their sending congregations who are financing their individual travel this July. We praise God for such generosity for the service to His Kingdom work!

The GTC module is held every 3 months in 15 different cities in Colombia. Although presenters receive no monetary remuneration for their preparation and teaching, GTC does assist with the payment of books, resources and materials for the participants, at the low total cost of \$3,000.00 per module, per city. That is where most of your dollars go when you give to Gospel through Colombia. If you or your church could support one module, or even a part of it, that would be great!

We are grateful for every individual donor who enjoys the privilege of giving back to the Lord what He graciously gives us. Bless your tender hearts!
