Our friends, Norma Lever from Pennsylvania and Brenda Henderson from Florida, assisted with music and sound.

We all felt so privileged to watch the pastors take their diploma and give glory to God that they received an excellent, comprehensive education at Seminario Reformado Latinoamericano.
